Alamo Heights ISD is committed to providing a rich, comprehensive experience for children in grades PK-12 that cultivates a love of learning, develops strong character and prioritizes leadership development. Students in AHISD are engaged in learning that focuses on their interests, talents and passions. Classroom experiences are relevant, rigorous and inspiring. RICH CURRICULUM: The curriculum is designed to cover major concepts with depth and complexity that prepares students for college and the 21st Century.

STUDENT ENGAGEMENT: While much of the nation focuses on teaching to state tests, the focus in AHISD is on designing quality learning experiences. No other school focuses more on engaging students in active learning experiences. All teachers are extensively trained in a collaborative design process that results in lessons that engage and inspire students.

STRATEGIC PLAN: The district recently completed 49 initiatives from a strategic plan that was written collaboratively by our community. This very ambitious plan has positively transformed student learning experiences.

DIVERSE COURSE OFFERINGS: Our students have the opportunity to take an amazing array and variety of courses, including 24 AP courses. There have been 19 courses added at AHHS based on student interests, some of which include Rocketry, Video Game Design, Astronomy, Digital Animation, Forensic Science, Yoga, CrossFit, Classical Guitar and Piano.

COLLEGE READINESS: Our students are very well-prepared for college. With 93% of graduates going to college, AHISD has more students than ever participating in AP courses and earning college credit hours. ACT scores in 2014 tied the record high set in 2013, and scores have steadily increased for the past seven years.

CHARACTER EDUCATION: Our Character Education program shapes and molds our students into outstanding young people who demonstrate integrity, kindness, humility and leadership. The district uses the 8 Keys of Excellence in grades PK-12, and incorporates character education into the daily curriculum.

STUDENT VOICE: As a learning organization, we are always seeking feedback and input, recognizing that in order to constantly grow, we need to amplify student voice in a variety of contexts, including regular course surveys, focus groups and luncheon meetings.

EXTRACURRICULAR OPPORTUNITIES: Our students are involved in school! With an extraordinary array of quality offerings, all students can pursue their talents and interests. Extracurricular activities are regularly ranked in the Top 10 in Texas (UIL Lone Star Cup).

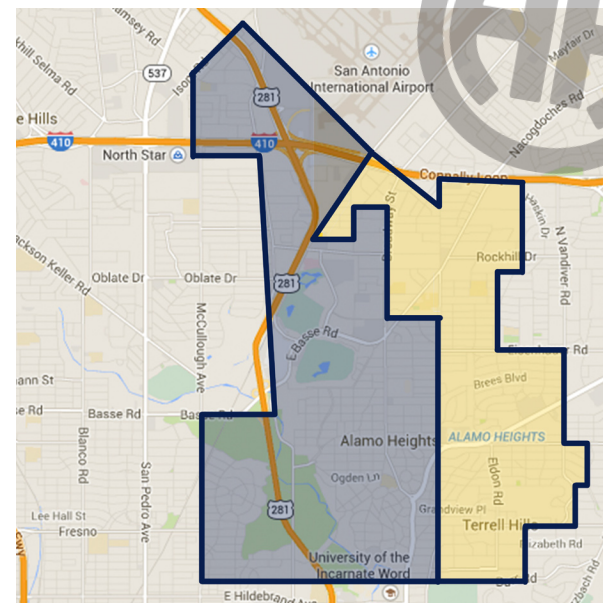
