School Board Trustee Elections General Information (as of January 2016)

- School board elections are held on the first Saturday of May every year
- There are 7 trustees that serve on staggered terms for 3 years
- Elections rotate between the 7 trustees as follows:
 - Place 1 & 2
 - Place 3 & 4
 - Place 5, 6, & 7
- Elections are called by the board at the January board meeting each year. This is published in the Board Briefs and posted to the district's website.
- The election notice and calendar are posted on the district's bulletin board at the Administration building (7101 Broadway)
- Applications for filing to run for the board are available at the business office of the district
- Under current law, filing as a candidate starts 108 days before the election and runs for 30 days
- State law requires school districts to hold joint elections with cities and counties
- Early voting starts 12 days before election day and voters can cast their vote at any site across Bexar county
- Election day voters must go to their precinct to cast their vote
- If candidates are unopposed then the district may cancel the election for that year
