ORDINANCE NO. 215

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING AN ANNUAL AD VALOREM TAX FOR THE YEAR 2015 SETTING SPECIFIC TAX RATES, APPLICABLE TO ALL REAL, PERSONAL AND MIXED PROPERTY SITUATED WITHIN ALAMO HEIGHTS INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT, SETTING DUE DATE AND PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES AND INTEREST ON DELINQUENT TAXES.

BE IT ORDERED by the Board of Trustees of Alamo Heights Independent School District of Bexar County, Texas:

- 1. That an ad valorem tax rate of \$1.195 per \$100.00 cash valuation and assessment ratio of 100% of market value be set and the same is hereby levied for the year of 2015 on all real, personal and mixed property located and situated within the confines and boundaries of the Alamo Heights Independent School District as of January 1, 2015.
- 2. That the above specified ad valorem tax be distributed as follows:
 - A. \$1.06 rate for general fund.
 - B. \$.135 rate for debt service fund.
- Any person failing to pay their taxes on or before January 31st shall be subject to maximum
 penalties thereon allowed by law to be collected on delinquent taxes. All delinquent taxes
 shall bear interest from the date of delinquency until paid.

THIS TAX RATE WILL RAISE MORE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS THAN LAST YEAR'S TAX RATE.
