Capítulo 7 - (parte 1 y parte 2) - La diversidad humana

Students will overcome obstacles due to racial, ethnic, or gender barriers, compare the past with the present, express how long an action has been going on, discuss race and gender, answer the question Why? and What for?, share experiences that promote positive behavior.
